He joined the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1986 and was the Dean of the Faculty of Business Administration, and a Professor in the Department of Decision Sciences and Managerial Economics. He was also the founding Director of the Asia-Pacific Institute of Business at the University. He is currently the Regional Vice President of Asia Pacific Decision Science Institute, and was the President of the Operations Research Society of Hong Kong , and Associate Editor of the Asia-Pacific Journal of Operational Research for the past many years.
